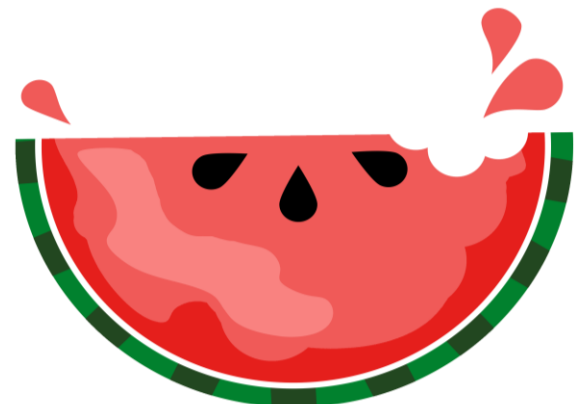
Billing for June and Summer:
